AGENDA ITEMS AND RELATED DISCUSSION

1. Review and approve past meeting minutes.

Outstanding point from 11/28/21: How do we poll islanders to collect more accurate and realistic impact statements with compelling stories?

DISCUSSION: Committee needs to figure out how and when to do this. Do not want to confuse this poll with the survey about what islanders want in a public dock.

Outstanding point from 11/28/21: Coordination of response to an unplanned ferry outage

DISCUSSION: The committee confirmed that current priorities are (1) gathering community input and (2) preparing for public presentations. Working on a detailed ferry outage response plan will become a higher priority after these tasks are complete.

2. Report on research into public docks other islands.

Reviewed key points of subcommittee's 12/4/21 discussion. Goal is to get good pictures, diagrams and design alternatives. <u>See this page for link to replay Zoom meeting.</u>

Task Assigned (Lane) – find out how to get design documents from Whatcom and San Juan County Parks to get good diagrams and accurate descriptions from suppliers who have built their docks. Need to contact Terri Terry or other managers.

3. Discuss plans for a community survey.

To consider – how much input do we solicit/require **before** presenting more concrete ideas? Or would it be better to propose a design and THEN ask for feedback?

Remember that Parks & Rec is in charge of the engineering and design. If we ask for public input on a wide range of options – maybe this is just opening a can of worms. We might end up introducing a list of ideas that will not be implemented by Parks & Rec. This seems like we might inadvertently undermine public trust in the planning process.

Committee decision TO CONFIRM-- Switch the order of tasks so that over the next 2 months we:

- 1. Publicize the committee's progress and related materials, inviting people to attend a Zoom meeting to learn more.
- 2. Host the meeting and present committee findings to collect public feedback.

 The presentation at the public meeting is the draft of what we would present to the county.
- 3. Publicize more by posting a recording of the meeting and making available the presentation with recommendations from the committee.
- 4. Conduct a public survey asking for input on specific committee recommendations. Look at Mary's list in Google doc to see a variety of thoughts on the survey.
- 5. Revise the presentation based on this input.
- 6. Schedule the presentation to Parks & Rec for late January/early February.
- 4. Work on presentation to build out content.
